Spring has arrived and the days are brighter and warmer. It is the ideal time to enjoy a crisp, refreshing Vinho Verde with some light starters and seafood dishes. Some reds can at this time of the year be served cool, this is the case for the Valpolicella Fidora on the seasonal selection, it will be a great alternative to white wine when matching fish dishes.

	Alvarinho Trajadura, Adega de Monção, 2021 VINHO VERDE, PORTUGAL A blend of Alvarinho with another indigenous variety, Trajadura, slightly more ripe and complex than typical examples from this region, with a refreshing spritz on the palate.	30.00
	Chardonnay, Stepping Stone Vineyards, 2021 MAPPINGA HILLS, AUSTRALIA Dry white natural wine, fresh and fruity with hints of acidity and white peach. Perfect in the sun with a salad or fish	35.00
	Valpolicella, Fidora, 2019 VENETO, ITALY Beautifully soft with bright cherry fruit and a slight peppery note, which is the distinctive touch of the Corvina grape variety.	35.00
	Saperavi, Tbilvino, 2021 KAKHETI, GEORGIA Made in a fruit-forward style, this wine highlights the grape's typical floral aromas, alongside bold flavours of forest fruits. The palate is well rounded and has an elegant, fresh finish.	34.00

Its complexity and its minerality is very much reminiscent of a top quality dry Riesling.	56.00
RED	55	Mencia, Petit Pittacum, 2021 BIERZO – VEGAN The region of Bierzo, inland of Galicia in the northwest of Spain, benefits from a unique microclimate which aids the winemaking process. Made with the local Mencia variety, Medium bodied, really juicy red fruit and cranberry characters with hints of herbs and spice.	39.00
	56	Crianza, Diaz Bayo, 2020 RIBEIRA DEL DUERO Made with the same grape variety as Rioja (Tempranillo) but showing more savoury characters with a real smokiness and hints of pepper, big but rounded tannins.	42.00
	57	Comando G, Garnacha, La Bruja de la Rozas, 2020 SIERRA DE GREDOS, MADRID – VEGAN La Bruja' consists of grapes from 50-80 year old vines based on granite soils, which are then fermented using wild yeasts before spending around 5 months in French oak. The resultant wine is young, fresh and playful, acting as a fantastic introduction to the potential of Garnacha from this intriguing, up-and-coming sub-region.	68.00
