## Wines of the Season

As the days are getting shorter and colder, there is nothing like a delicious glass of wine to warm you up in front of the fire. We have selected some wines that will warm your heart and compliment braised winter dishes.

<p><b>Dao Branco, Prunus, 2021</b> DAO, PORTUGAL Encruzado and Malvasia blend. Well-rounded and harmonious, with notes of tinned peaches and fresh herbs, a fresh juicy palate and a long, mouthwatering finish.</p> <p><b>Orange Wine*, Salamandre, 2022</b> SOUTH OF FRANCE 100% Grenache Blanc. Juicy and fleshy white wine with delicious orange and peachy flavours, will accompany meaty fish dishes and white meat dishes.</p> <p><b>Réserve du Couvent, Château Ksara, 2020</b> BEKAA VALLEY, LEBANON Syrah, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon blend. A ready-to-drink, medium to full-bodied wine, with layered flavours and aromas of fruit and spice with body and freshness.</p> <p><b>Merlot Soli, Edoardo Miroglio, 2019</b> THRACE VALLEY, BULGARIA A Merlot packed with plums, ripe blackcurrant and bramble, with notes of oak, hints of cedar and tobacco. <p><b>53</b> <b>Rioja Blanco, Hacienda Grimón, 2021</b> RIOJA, SPAIN From this small family estate in the heart of Rioja, a fresh white wine with zesty citrus and stone fruits flavours.</p> <p><b>54</b> <b>O Rosal, Bodegas Terras Gaudas, 2021/22</b> RIAS BAIXAS, GALICIA – VEGAN O Rosal Terras Gauda is a selective blend of Albariño grapes in the O Rosal Subzone and is mixed with the indigenous Loureira and Caino Blanco. Its complexity and its minerality is very much reminiscent of a top quality dry Riesling.</p>	<p>37.00</p> <p>58.00</p>
<p><b>55</b> <b>Mencia, Petit Pittacum, 2021</b> BIERZO – VEGAN The region of Bierzo, inland of Galicia in the northwest of Spain, benefits from a unique microclimate which aids the winemaking process. Made with the local Mencia variety, Medium bodied, really juicy red fruit and cranberry characters with hints of herbs and spice.</p> <p><b>56</b> <b>Crianza, Diaz Bayo, 2020</b> RIBEIRA DEL DUERO Made with the same grape variety as Rioja (Tempranillo) but showing more savoury characters with a real smokiness and hints of pepper, big but rounded tannins.</p> <p><b>57</b> <b>Comando G, Garnacha, La Bruja de la Rozas, 2020</b> SIERRA DE GREDOS, MADRID – VEGAN La Bruja' consists of grapes from 50-80 year old vines based on granite soils, which are then fermented using wild yeasts before spending around 5 months in French oak.
